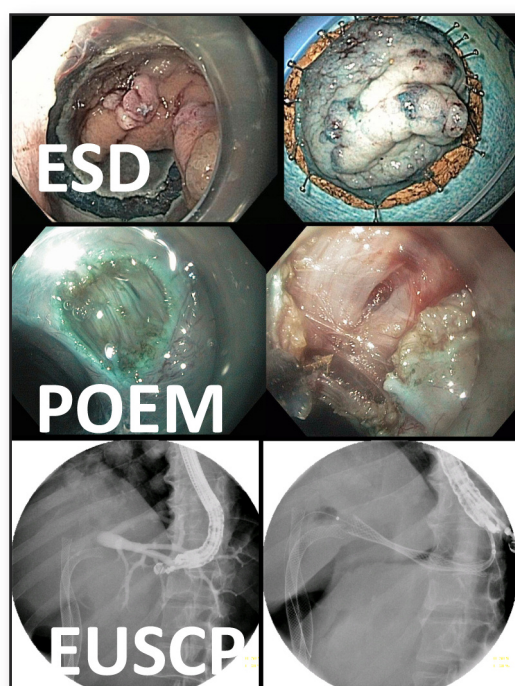


**4<sup>th</sup> Annual Long Island Live Endoscopy Course 2012**  
**From EUS-Guided Transluminal Interventions to POEM**

Join us for a day of cutting-edge live procedures and lectures covering a broad range of "hot" topics in advanced therapeutic endoscopy.

**A live per-oral endoscopic myotomy (POEM) procedure** will be performed by Dr. Stavros Stavropoulos, Activity Director for the course. The first POEM outside Japan was performed at Winthrop in 2009 by Dr. Stavropoulos ([see video at: http://www.youtube.com/watch?v=7IDn-w27wPo](http://www.youtube.com/watch?v=7IDn-w27wPo)). Data will be presented from the Winthrop experience, which spans over two years and constitutes the largest US series of POEM in treatment-naive achalasia patients.



**Endoscopic submucosal dissection (ESD)** for en-block resection of early mucosal cancers and submucosal tumors is another expert technique at early stages of adoption in the US. Winthrop has been among the few pioneering centers for ESD in the US, with the largest series of ESD for submucosal tumors. ESD will be demonstrated live, and data from the early US experience, as well as strategies for ESD adoption, will be discussed.

**Other live cases** selected will demonstrate advanced techniques and devices such as EUS-FNI, pseudocyst drainage, EUS-guided biliary drainage, difficult cannulation, ampullectomy, Spyglass/thin scope cholangioscopy, electrohydraulic lithotripsy, RFA for cholangiocarcinoma, biliary hilar stenting, luminal stents, Cellvizio confocal microscopy, Zenker's diverticulotomy, use of OTSC (over the scope clips) and advanced polypectomy.

**A faculty of innovative, expert therapeutic endoscopists**

**Dr. Kenneth Binmoeller** will serve as guest moderator and provide the keynote lecture **in memory of Peter D. Stevens, MD**, a colleague, mentor and friend to many in our field. Dr. Binmoeller has been a pioneer in advanced EUS techniques and will discuss EUS-guided coil embolization and novel devices for pseudocyst drainage and EUS guided transluminal biliary/gallbladder stenting. **Dr. Gregory Haber**, an internationally recognized ERCP master, will discuss tips and tricks for altered anatomy ERCP. **Dr. Michel Kahaleh**, one of the earliest US adopters of PDT, RFA and confocal microscopy for cholangiocarcinoma, will discuss advanced techniques for cholangiocarcinoma diagnosis and treatment. **Dr. Frank Gress**, a master endosonographer with extensive contributions to the field, will discuss advanced EUS applications for pancreatic cancer. **Dr. Jonathan Buscaglia**, a distinguished therapeutic endoscopist, author of a recent multicenter study on esophageal stenting for benign disease, will discuss expert techniques in managing benign strictures, fistulas and leaks.
